Call for Tenders for the MANIF AFM corrective and evolutive maintenance 2018-2020

The European Organisation for the Safety of Air Navigation (EUROCONTROL) was founded in 1960 by six States. It now has 41 Member States. EUROCONTROL's mission is to harmonise and integrate air navigation services in Europe, aiming at the creation of a uniform air traffic management (ATM) system for civil and military Users, in order to achieve the safe, secure, orderly, expeditious and economic flow of traffic throughout Europe, while minimising adverse environmental impact.

Commission Regulation (EU) No 677/2011 laying down detailed rules for the implementation of air traffic management (ATM) network functions and amending Regulation (EU) No 691/2010, was adopted on the 7 July 2011. EUROCONTROL received the Network Manager nomination from the European Commission on the 18 July 2011.

The implementation of the air traffic management (ATM) network functions requires the Network Manager to perform the coordination of radio frequencies within the aviation frequency bands used by general air traffic. The detailed requirements for this coordination function are set out in Annex II of Regulation (EU) No 677/2011 which is titled The Radio Frequency Function (RFF).

The Radio Frequency Function Regulation (EU) No 677/2011 states in Annex II, part A point 19 provides the following:

“The Network Manager shall ensure the availability of common tools to support central and national planning, coordination, registration, auditing and optimisation. In particular, tools shall be developed to support the analysis of the central register data to monitor the efficiency of the function and to design and implement the frequency optimisation process under point 7.”

MANIF (MANagement Intéreactif des Fréquences) is the Windows PC software tool suite developed and maintained by EUROCONTROL NM and made available to all European States to support their aeronautical frequencies planning and their auditing and optimisation. MANIF AFM (Advanced Frequency Management) is a standalone PC software to analyse the use of frequencies. MANIF DQS (Data Quality Server) is a tool providing SAFIRE users with an evaluation of the quality of the Frequency Assignments data contained into the SAFIRE database. It is a server version of the AFM software that makes available MANIF functions to SAFIRE. SAFIRE (Spectrum And Frequencies Information REsource) is the web-based software tool developed and maintained by NM to support central and national planning, coordination and registration.

The purpose of the present Call for Tenders is to sign a contract aiming at providing corrective and evolutive maintenance for the MANIF tool suite. This contract will include changes to MANIF and the DQS to use the data provided by the future SAFIRE v6.
