Price Enquiry for the provision of the SPPAT Upgrade 2018

EUROCONTROL is an intergovernmental organisation made up of 41 Member States. Founded in 1960, it is a civil-military organisation that has developed into a vital European repository of air traffic management (ATM) excellence.

EUROCONTROL DPS, through its Support to States and Regional Initiatives function, has engaged in responding to the requests for assistance of the Member States' Authorities, mainly NSAs/CAAs, to implement their tasks related to performance and business plans developments and the monitoring of their implementation.

In this context, DPS/SSR developed a software tool, named "Strategic Planning & Performance Assessment Tool (SPPAT)", intended primarily for performance and business plans development and for the monitoring of their implementation. SPPAT is also a decision making support tool assessing the sustainability and performance of the strategic business plan of any given aviation regulator and/or air navigation service provider.

In order to improve the performance of the application it was decided to host it on EUROCONTROL servers. To allow the migration from the Azure cloud infrastructure to the EUROCONTROL server environment, the SPPAT software should be converted, transforming the desktop application to a pure web application accessible remotely via https. At the same time, since new regulations or amendments are frequently published and changes are made in the reporting forms, a need arises on the tool continuous maintenance, development and upgrades.

A price enquiry is requested covering the period until end 2018, during which a new generation of SPPAT shall be developed in line with the technical specifications attached. This new generation of the SPPAT tool will fully address the new requirements of the CAAs/NSAs together with the regulation on Airspace Users and Airports. Moreover the resulting tool shall conform fully to the SES and EASA Regulatory Framework.
